



All lit up at John Lewis

Architect Wilson Mason & Partners has revealed images of its ongoing £62 million refurbishment of John Lewis Partnership's flagship Oxford Street store.

Two central light wells have been created to flood the shop

with natural light, the second of which has just opened, and glass-sided escalators provide unobstructed views beneath the domed membrane roof.

The project will be completed with the opening of a new food hall in the autumn.
